Road 242, a distance of approximately 4.2 miles, subject to the condition that Sabine County will furnish all required right of way clear of obstructions and free of cost to the State.

At such time as the County shall accept the provision of this Order and agree to the furnishing of the required right of way, the State Highway Engineer is directed to proceed with the engineering development and construction of the project in the most feasible and economical manner, at an estimated cost of \$165,000, and to assume the road for State maintenance upon completion of the construction herein authorized.

This Order is subject to acceptance by the County and if not accepted within 90 days of the date hereof, the action herein contained shall be automatically cancelled.

The Court issued a Commissioners Court Order pertaining to Minute Order No. 59486 to-wit:

The Commissioners Court of Sabine County in regular session in its office at the Court-house in Hemphill, Texas on June 12, 1967 studied Minute Order 59486 issued by Texas Highway Department June 2, 1967. Due to the fact that the above mentioned minutes moves the original allocation of road in question and due to the fact that such action has been and is being unanimously condemned by the citizenship of the area, the Commissioners Court finds it necessary to unanimously refuse to approve this order at this particular time.

The Commissioners Court will, however, be glad to accept the road mileage involved in some other place in Sabine County in the event the Highway Department finds it impossible to revert to the original location.

On motion by Commissioner H. W. Wright and seconded by Commissioner T. A. Seales and with all members voting "AYE", the matter of renewing Sabine County's application to United States Department of Agriculture for Commodities for free distribution was approved by the Court.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.
