Motion by Paul Lout and seconded by T. A. Seales that Notice is hereby given that on April 8, 1968 the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, meeting in regular session after due public notice, voted to designate the Tri-County Community Action, Inc., 118 Selma, Center, Texas 75935, as the agency to conduct anti-proverty activities in this county. The TCCA, Inc. is the agency currently conducting anti-proverty activities in Sabine County.

A survey made by J. H. Ener of the Forest Service Roads of Sabine County was accepted by the Court, BEGINNING at point in center line of Road No. 115, where same intersects State High No. 87. Beginning point being S. 68 W. 387 feet and N. 84½ W. 220 feet from the N. W. corner of the Eli. Low Survey, same being the original N. W. corner of the S. T. Mason tract of land, Beginning at the N. W. corner of the Eli Low Survey iron pipe for corner, bearing trees marked U.S.B.T. and painted with red paint. Field notes being recorded in Volume 2, page 80-81 of Field Notes of Sabine County, Texas.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
