The Court authorized the County Judge and County Sheriff to select a boat and life saving equipment to be purchased for use by the Sheriff(s) Department and to prepare an advertisement for the local paper.

Motion by Commissioner, Paul Lout, and seconded by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn the Court voted to increase salaries of key employees in Commissioner Precincts by 25 cents per hour.

From St. 21, 3.8 miles East of Milam, South a distance of approximately 2.8 miles.
