Gentlemen:
This has reference to the appearance of a Sabine County delegation before the Texas Highway Commission on September 30th, concerning a request for certain Farm to Market roads in Sabine County, including roads in the Toledo Bend Reservoir area, and one additional road in the Sam Rayburn Reservoir vicinity.

It is the purpose of this letter to recommend the priority under which our proposals are made.

1. We agree $w i$ th the Commission that the matter of most importance is the 1.9 mile gap is Farm 3121 between Farm to Market 83 and State. Highway il. We submit this as our number one proposal.
2. We submit as our number two the road from State Highway 87, South of Yellowpine along U. S. F. S. road number 115 as shown by you number 23 on your March 1967 brochure. This road is necessary to serve the Oak Hill Community. The distance is 8.4 miles. This rad is necessary because F.M. 944 no longer serves this area.
3. Our number three recommendation is the extension of F. M. 2866 from F. M. 83 South to Sam Rayburn Lake. Your brochure number 39.
4. The Cedar Grove Road from State Highway 21 to State Highway 87 serving about 50 families and is a school bus and RFD route.
5. The extension of F. M. 276 to F. M. 330 at Geneva, Texas.
