The following Resolution was approved by the Court:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE
DEEP EAST TEXAS DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to plan for the future development of the region so as to obtain optimum benefits for the residents thereof; and

WHEREAS this goal is more readily attainable through cooperative effort at the local governmental unit level:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SABINE COUNTY:

1. That participation in the Deep East Texas Development Council is hereby authorized.
2. That the Articles of Agreement whereby these counties agreed to establish a regional planning commission shall be executed and entered into effective this date.
3. That the duties, responsibilities, financial resources and obligations, staff and property of the Deep East Texas Economic Development District be accepted by the Deep East Texas Development Council.

Reference is made to our recent conversation and visit to the area shown on the

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attached map.

As indicated on the map, certain parts of the reservoir take line are adjacent to the road right of way which was formerly FM 276. Pursuant to Section II, C, 1 of the Rules and Regulations adopted by the Board of Directors of the Sabine River Authority of Texas, it is the policy that the adjacent property owner shall have the first refusal for the right to limited use of the area between the take line and the water level. Therefore, we are hereby offering to Sabine County the Limited Use of the area shown in green on the attached map.

If the County does not wish to make use of this area please so indicate on the attached copy hereof and we will offer the use of this area to Mr. Sam Williams who has recently made application with us for use of the area.
