The Court adopted the following:

RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE SABINE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

IMPORTED FIRE ANT

WHEREAS, the Imported Fire Ant poses a serious threat to the lives and property of a large segment of the population of Texas, both rural and urban, and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Agriculture has provisions for matching funds to combat the intrusion of this pest into this state and nation, and

WHEREAS, it would be to the distinct advantage of all the citizens of Texas for the state to participate with the Federal Government in a program of control and eradication of the Imported Fire Ant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sabine County Commissioners Court, that the Legislature of the State of Texas be requested to appropriate a sufficient amount of funds approximately one million dollars annually, at its next regular session, 1969, to meet the requirements of the existing Federal matching funds for a program of control and eradication of the Imported Fire Ant.

The Court entered into a Lease Agreement with H. W. Wright, Lessor and the County of Sabine, Lessee which is recorded in Volume 134 Page 643 Deed Records, Sabine County, Texas.

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The following Contract was unanimously approved by the Court:

WHEREAS, Carl E. Smith, Assessor-Collector of Taxes for Sabine County, Texas did enter into a contract with C. R. Law Tax Records, Ind. on the 28th day of August, A. D. 19 67: whereby C. R. Law Tax Records, Inc. did agree and bind itself to prepare and compile a Delinquent Tax Record for Sabine County, Texas, as provided for in Article 7336F Revised Civil Statutes, for the years 1939 to 1966, both inclusive, which said contract was duly and regularly approved by the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, it is now the desire of Carl E. Smith, Assessor-Collector of Taxes for Sabine County, Texas, and C. R. Law Tax Records, Inc. to amend said contract to extend the period to include the years 1939 to 1967, both inclusive, and have so signified by their signatures affixed to this instrument, and it being the desire of this court to make such amendment to the contract: IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by this court that the amended contract be and the same is hereby approved to include the years 1939 to 1967, both inclusive.

Motion by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn, seconded by Commissioner T. A. Seales and with all members voting "AYE", the County Attorney's salary was adjusted to \$4200.00 per year, effective February 1, 1969.

The Court approved the appointment of L. B. Cupit, Deputy Sheriff and fixed his salary at \$3336.00 per year and expenses \$2400.00 effective February 1, 1969.

The Court further approved the appointment of H. W. Wright as Dispatcher for the Sheriff's Department and fixed his salary at \$200.00 per month.

Motion by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and all members voting "AYE" the Court approved a motion that the Tax Assessor-Collector be authorized to hire Mary Beth Parker for a period beginning January 13, 1969 and ending April 30, 1969 at a salary of \$182.00 per month.

The Court approved the Annual Budget of the County Agent as follows:  
\$1119.00 Salary      \$499.92 Travel Expense

The County Treasurer is directed to apportion the balance now in Road and Bridge Fund to the various Commissioner Precinct as follows:

- Precinct # 1      21%
- Precinct # 2      29%
- Precinct # 3      21%
- Precinct # 4      29%

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The County Treasurer is directed to transfer from Road and Bridge Fund the following amounts to Officers Salary Fund for the purpose of paying the Salaries and Expense accounts of the various Commissioners and 3/4 of the Salary and Expense account of the County Judge..

Precinct # 2	\$6134.00
Precinct # 3	\$6134.00
Precinct # 4	\$6134.00

The Treasurer is directed to transfer from the Jury Fund to Officers Salary Fund \$3084.00.

The Treasurer is directed to transfer from P. I. Fund to Officers Salary Fund the amount of \$2646.00.

The Treasurer is directed to transfer from Road Bridge Tax to Officers Salary Fund the amount of \$10,000.00.

All accounts were allowed and made payable,  
There being no further business Court adjourned.
