The County Attorney was directed by the Court to prepare necessary papers to combine voting p recinct No. 12 at Fairmount with voting precinct No. 7 at yellowpine, and to combine/<sup>voting</sup> Precinct No. 18 at Lows Chapel with/<sup>voting</sup> precinct No. 4 at Milam.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.
