On this the 13th day of April, 1970, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in regular session with the following members present, to-wit:

Upon request of the USDA the court voted to delete from the STANDARD OF ELIGIBILITY FOR DISTRIBUTING USDA DONATED FOODS the following three items:

1. U. S. citizenship (####) (Will not) be required.
2. Residence in the County for a period of 6 months (will) (#####) be required.
3. Residence in the State for a period of 12 months (will) (#####) be required.

Motion by Commissioner, T. A. Seales, seconded by Commissioner, R. E. Smith, and by unanimous consent the court authorized the County Agent to employ a secretary for three months only at a salary of \$200.00 per month.

C. J. Saboites, District Ranger USDA Forest Service appeared before the Court to discuss solid waste disposal and sanitary land fills with respect to public law 91-190 and State of Texas House Bill 1367 which are now in effect.

Motion by Commissioner, R. E. Smith seconded by Commissioner Paul Lout with all voting "AYE" the Court approved a Plat of EL CAMINO BAY and ACTION BY COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS, CANCELLING THE DEDICATION OF COUNTY ROAD C-19A and RELINQUISHING ALL PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY IN AND TO THE LAND COVERED BY SAID EASEMENT, which will be recorded in Deed Records Sabine County.

The Court ordered the County Treasurer to transfer funds from Road & Bridge Special to the various Precincts according to percentages heretofore used.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the court adjourned.
