Motion by Paul Lout and seconded by T. A. Seales, to approve the bond and oath of Charlotte M. Ladner as Assistant Deputy Tax Assessor-Collector. The bond is recorded in Vol. 8, page 87 of Official Bond Records of Sabine County, Texas.

Motion was made by R. E. Smith, seconded by T. A. Seales, it was unanimously ordered that the Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, make application to the State Department of Public Welfare for food commodities donated by the U. S. Department of Agriculture.

It was further ordered that Lois Smith be appointed Authorized Representative

and is hereby given full responsibility and authority for all matters pertinent to the receipt, storage, and use of such food commodities, and the maintenance of all records.

The standard of eligibility is to be used for the year beginning September 1, 1970 and ending August 31, 1971 unless or until some change is proposed and approved in writing.

Recipients of Old Age, Aid to the Blind, Aid to Dependent Children, Aid to the Permanently and Totally Disabled and their normal dependents are hereby declared to be eligible, on a blanket basis, to receive Commodities, provided the other conditions are met on an individual case basis. The term "Normal Dependents" may consist of an eligible spouse, minor children or mentally or physically incapacitated adult children living with and dependent on the head of the household.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
