Gentlemen:

Please accept this document and the enclosed plans as an application from Sabine County for a 1.51 acre easement on U. S. Government owned land on Sam Rayburn Reservoir, Texas, Tract 1105, for a public boat ramp. Eight copies of the proposed easement area are attached.

Consent to easement is also requested on 0.49 acres of flowage easement land, Tract 1105-E3, as shown on the drawing. Eight copies of easement from W. L. Defoyd to Sabine County are also attached.

Whereas the nearest public boat ramp is more than fifteen miles distance from this location, we now hereby request approval of construction of the facilities shown on the enclosed plans and agree to perform all required future maintenance of these facilities.
