Representatives from Shamrock Shores Sub-Division with their attorneys appeared before the Court to discuss thermoad situation in Shamrock Shores and the responsibilities of the County concerning maintenance of the roads. It was agreed by the parties the Commissioner, H. E. Wilburn would meet with their representatives and grade a small portion of one of these roads to determine what could be done to help these roads.

The Court authorized payment of \$100.00 toward the funeral expense of Melvin Woodard.

Motion by Commissioner, R. K. Smith, seconded by Commissioner, T. A. Seales the Court voted to accept the employment of L. B. Cupit as Deputy Sheriff and Gladys Nadine Gary as Secretary to County Agent at a salary heretofore determined.

Motion by Commissioner, Paul Loût, seconded by Commissioner, H. E. Wilburn the Court vtoed unanimously to divide equally on 25% basis to each Precinct all Road & Bridge Funds received by the County for this fund.

The Court authorized the County Service Officer to employ temporary help for a period of not more than 90 days for 3 days each week at a salary of \$30.00 per week.

. The Court voted to prorate the County Taxes collected from the current tax roll in the following manner:

10/16 General Fund

3/16 Road & Bridge Fund

- 1/16 Jury Fund
- 2/16 P & I Fund

All accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being nor further business the Court adjourned.
