On this the 12th day of October, 1970, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in regular session with the following members present, to-wit:

E. L. Beauchamp and Mr. Radaliff appeared before the Court to discuss maintenance of roads on Sam Rayburn Estates. Standards set by the County for acceptance of roads in sub-divisions were explained and when these conditions are met the County would accept these roads on approval of Commissioner, Precinct No. 1.

Mr. Saboites and Mr. Keel of the U. S. Forest Service asked for county participation in maintenance of Forest Roads 115 and 115 B. Details to be worked out between the Commissioner, Precinct No. 1 and U. S. Forest Service.

The County agreed to accept two roads of .3 mile and .4 mile from L. C. Hammock, when U. S. Forest Service furnish the County with the proper easements.

The Court ordered County Treasurer to transfer 50% of funds received from U. S. Forest Service to the County Board of Education for distribution to the schools according to law. The County Treasurer is also directed to prorate the remainder of the fund to the various Precincts at 25% to each Precinct after the Treasurer has deducted his commission.






Motion by Wilburn seconded by Seales and with all voting "Aye" the Court voted to accept the foregoing bid.


All accounts were allowed and made payable.
