Motion made by R. E. Smith, seconded by H. E. Wilburn that Sabine County enter into an Agreement with the Texas State Department of Public Welfare for the establishment and operation of a Commodity Distribution Program to be funded in part by United States Department of Agriculture; such a Program to be for an indefinite period of time and Judge O. A. Beauchamp be authorized to sign the necessary application to accomplish this. The need eligibility standard for this program shall be the State Standard. Further that all recipients of Public Assistance and their normal dependents shall be eligible to receive commodities without reference to income or other need factors and no citizenship or residence requirements are established other than recipients must reside in Sabine County.
