On this the 25th day of January, 1971, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in regular session with the following members present, to-wit:

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner, Paul Lout and with all voting "AYE" the Court tentatively declared the old road from J. B. McGeesto E. C. Smith to be a County Road and field notes to the road to be furnished later.

Motion by Commissioner, Paul Lout, seconded by Commissioner, T. A. Seales and by unanimous vote the court ordered the Clerk of Court to publish notices for Depository Pledge Contracts for both the County and School Funds.

Upon request of Lois Smith, Commodity Supervisor the number of persons to receive commodities was raised from 600 to 800 and the clerk was ordered to issue a warrant for \$72.00 which is .36 cents for 200 additional persons.

Motion by Commissioner, T. A. Seales, seconded by Commissioner, R. E. Smith the Court affirmed the request of Norman Birdwell that the County ask for bids on gasoline, diesel, motor oil and lubricants and the Clerk of the Court was directed to prepare the notices to be published in a local newspaper.

After hearing testimony by the County Attorney concerning his opinion on the law about a county audit, motion by Commissioner, T. A. Seales, seconded by Commissioner, R. E. Smith the court voted unanimously to deny the request of Norman Birdwell to audit all County books to include all years back to January 1, 1950.

Jim Ellis, Chairman of Solid Waste Disposal Committee, along with D. B. Speights and Sam Malone appeared before the Court and discussed the garbage problem and what was being done to get the program started. Mr. Wllis stated that he would soon have the legal description of six garbage sites.

Truett Craven, Motorola Representative, gave the Court the current status of the new communications system for the Sheriff's Department.

Gene Morris submitted a Group Insurance plan from Blue Cross for the Court's

consideration.

Motion by Commissioner, R. E. Smith and seconded by T. A. Seales, the Court ordered the transfer of funds to Officers Salary Fund as follows:
