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Motion by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and by unanimous vote the Court authorized O. P. Pate, County Service Officer to employ a temporary clerk for 3 days a week at \$10.00 per day through the months of November and December of 1971 and January of 1972.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith seconded by Commissioner Paul Lout the Court voted unanimously to take a Major Medical Group Insurance Pobicy together with a \$2500.00 Life Insurance Policy with Citizens Standard Life Insurance Co., Corpus PARticipATING Christi, Texas on each County Employee effective November 1, 1971. Wife or dependents will not be covered by the Life Insurance Policy.

Motion by Commissioner B. E. Smith seconded by Commissioner T. A. Seales and all voting "AYE", the Court accepted for maintenance roads in Riverbend Subdivision, Lowes Greek Village Subdivision and Beechwood Subdivision.

The Court approved the Bond of Letitia Gaylê Johnson, Deputy Tax Assessor-Collector. The Court voted to divide Ad Valorem Taxes as follows:

10/16 General Fund

3/16 Road & Bridge Fund

1/16 Jury Fund .

2/16 Permanent Improvement Fund

Motion by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn seconded by Commissioner T. A. Seales and by unanimous consent the Court voted to authorize Sheriff Blan Greer to employ a Special Deputy Sheriff and Pound Master for Sabine County, subject to approval of the Court and the Sheriff was further directed to build or secure æ Pound Pen to impound livestock.

The following Amendment to Lease Agreement was approved by the Court:

AMENDMENT TO LEASE AGREEMENT

THE STATE OF TEXAS I COUNTY OF SABINE I

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WHEREAS, by Lease dated the 28th day of June, 1971, Temple Industries, Inc., as Lessor, leased to the County of Sabine, Texas, as Lessee, certain land andpremises therein described for use as sites for Solid Waste Disposal, to which Lease reference is here made for all of the terms and provisions thereof; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Sabine, herein called Lessee, desires to lease from Temple Industries, Inc., herein called Lessor, another tract of land for use as a site for Solid WasteDisposal, together with a right-of-way and easement for access from a public road to and from such site, which Lease and Right-of-Way Lessor is willing to grant upon the same terms and conditions as contained in such Lease Agreement of June 28, 1971;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

1. Lessor, in consideration of its desire to assist the County of Sabine and and its citizens to make sanitary disposition of garbage and solid waste material and of the agreements of Lessee herein contained, does hereby grant, lease and let, subject to the exceptions, reservations and conditions herein contained, unto Lessee for use as a site for solid waste disposal, that certain tract of land described in EXHIBIT "A" attached to and made a part hereof, together with a right-df-way and easement for ingress and egress to and from such tract to the public raod by foot, vehicular and animal traffic, such easement being described in said EXHIBIT "A" in
