DEDICATION OF PUBLIC ROAD

I, W. B. WARNER of Sabine County, Texas being the owner of the following described property in Sabine County, Texas do hereby set aside and dedicate to the public use as a road or street the following described property lying and being

situated in Sabine County, Texas, to-wit:

BEING 2.73 acres of land, more or less out of and a part of Abstract No. 81, Daniel Crenshaw Survey, Sabine County, Texas and being a strip of land 50 feet in width, 25 feet on each side of the following described centerline;

BEGINNING 1154.5 feet south and 1333.6 feet west from the north corner of said Crenshaw Survey.

THENCE with said centerline as follows:

S 83° 31' W - 209.4 feet

S 71° 04' W - 460.0 feet

S 49° 15' W - 200.0 feet

S 13° 47' W - 300.0 feet

S 16° 23' E - 200.0 feet

S 10° 46' W - 483.0 feet

S 5° 00' E - 525.0 feet to a point in graded county road.

25 ft. ROW to T.W. McDaniel Camp  
50 ft. ROW to Old Devils Tower and a portion to Gillies Point.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business the Court adjourned.
