Motion by Commissioner, Paul Lout, seconded by Commissioner, R. E. Smith by unanimous vote, the Court authorized Jesse J. Moody an increase of \$50.00 per month effective November 1, 1971/for hauling commodities.

Motion by Commissioner, T. A. Seales, seconded by Commissioner, Paul Lout the Court authorized the closing of that portion of the Old Scrapping Valley Road to Brookeland where it crosses a 101 acre tract of land purchased by H. B. Neal from John Veatch in the James McKim League, Abstract No. 39.

The Court authorized the County to enter into a lease agreement with H. W. Wright for property on which to construct a Livestock Pound Pen together with water for the pen. Rate to be \$25.00 per year for the land and \$3.50 per month for water. Other details of the Lease Agreement to be worked out between the parties.

Motion by Commissioner, Paul Lout seconded by Commissioner, H. E. Wilburn and with all voting "AYE" the Court authorized the County to secure 4000 lbs. of Mierex in 2 lbs. bags from the Plant Pest Control Division, Department of Agriculture Austip, Texas for storage and distribution.

Motion by Commissioner, H. E. Smith and seconded by Commissioner, H. E. Wilburn the Court authorized the County Judge to proceed with plans to purchase radio communication equipment for the Sheriff's Department of Sabine County from the Criminal Justice Council of the Deep East Texas Development Council.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.
