Voting for the motion were Commissioner Paul Loutaand Commissioner R. E. Smith. Voting against the motion were Commissioner T. A. Seales and Commissioner H. E. Wilburn. Since the voting was tied two for and two against, the County Judge broke the tie by voting for the motion. The County Judge pointed out that any land weener on this road who wanted cattle guards where stock gaps are located could install a suitable iron cattle guard at his own expense.

Motion by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith the Court voted unanimously to accept dedication of public roads in SHAMROCK SHORES SUBDIVISIONS on file in Plat Records as of this date.

The Court instructed the Clerk of Court to reply to a letter from Clint Davis concerning a letter from Clint Davis, 1114 Beaver Bend Road, Houston, Texas, March 17, 1972 complaining of over-paying taxes on Lot No. 28 in Lake Sam Rayburn Estates The Court instructed the Clerk to reply that there could be no refund of \$50.00 plus interest.
