The Court canvassed the Returns for the County Trustee Election.

Mr. J. N. Welsh appeared before the Court about the "Old Flat Road" to the old Cox place. Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner T. A. Seales the court voted to open the road by either unlocking the gate or giving Mrs. Welsh a key to go through to haul his timber.

Lloyd Conn appeared in regard to the roads to the Boat Ramp on Lake Sam Rayburn Estates. Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn the Court voted, authorizing Commissioner T. A. Seales to take care of the roads and the people would do the mowing and picking up the garbage.

The following request was presented to the Court.

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SABINE COUNTY:

I respectfully request the Court to hire Mrs. Doris Wilson to replace Mrs. Gayle Johnson as Deputy Clerk in the Tax Assessor-Collector's office of Sabine County.

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Motion by Commissioner T. A. Seales, seconded by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn the Court voted to accept the roads in WOODLAND ESTATES SUBDIVISION, SECTION NO. 1.

Petition was submitted to the court for new Justice Precinct which will include all of Voting Precinct No. 7. Motion by Commissioner T. A. Seales, seconded by Commissioner Paul Lout and with the Court voting "AYE" the following Resolution was passed:

On this 24 day of April, 1972, the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, convened in Regular Session at the Courthouse of the City of Hemphill, Texas, with the following members present to-wit:

AND, among other proceedings had, there was presented to the Court a Petition bearing the names of a number of residents and qualified voters in the S. E. portion of Sabine County, Texas, which Petition requested the Court to establish a Justice of the Peace Precinct in that area of the County; and

WHEREAS the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas has considered the matter and deems it appropriate to create such a Justice of the Peace Precinct

NOW THEREFORE,

Be it ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas;

That a Justice of the Peace Precinct to be known as Justice of the Peace, Precinct Number 5 is herewith created and laid out, and shall encompass that area of Sabine County, Texas described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at the Southeast corner of Sabine County where the South line of said county intersects the Sabine River or Toledo Bend Reservoir:

THENCE Westerly along the South line of Sabine County, being the Sabine-newton County line to the intersection of said County line with the West line of the Jesse McGee Survey, A-37.

THENCE Northerly with the W. line of the said McGee Survey to its N. W. corner;

THENCE Easterly along the N. line of said McGee Survey to S. W. corner of the H. & T. C. Ry. Co. Survey, A-128;

THENCE Easterly along the S. line of said H. & T. C. Ry. Co. Survey to its S. E. corner;

THENCE N. along the E. line of said H. & T. C. Ry. Co. Survey to its N. E. corner of John H. Kirby Survey, A-411;

THENCE Easterly along the N. line of said Kirby Survey, A-411, to the S. W. corner of J. H. Kirby Survey, A-417;

THENCE Northerly along the W. line of the said Kirby Survey, A-417 to its N. W. Corner;

THENCE Easterly along the N. line of the said Kirby, A-417 to the S. E. corner of J. H. Kirby Survey, A-403;

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THENCE Northerly along the E. line of the said Kirby Survey, A-403 to its N. E. corner also being an interior corner of the Cad Davis Survey, A-13;

THENCE N. along the W. line of the said Cad Davis Survey to its N. W. corner and a corner of the T. & N. O. Ry. Co. Survey, A-233;

THENCE Westerly and Northerly with the lines of the said T. & N. O. A-233 to the S. W. line of the W. M. Cain Survey, A-213;

THENCE S. Easterly with the S. W. line of the Cain Survey to the S. E. corner of said Cain Survey;

THENCE N. Easterly with the S. E. line of said Survey to its N. E. corner, being the S. W. corner of the L. Jones Survey, A-266;

THENCE Northerly along the W. lines of the L. Jones Survey and the L. S. Whittlesey Survey, A-463 to the S. W. corner of the Wm. M. Davis Survey, A-89;

THENCE Northeasterly along its W. line to its most Northerly corner;

THENCE Southeasterly along the N. line of said Davis Survey to the SE corner of the Sion Smith Survey, A-55;

THENCE Northeasterly along the Smith E. line to the SW corner of the John Haley Survey;

THENCE Easterly along the Haley Survey S line to its SE corner;

THENCE Northerly along the E. line of said Haley Survey to Housen Bayou;

THENCE Easterly and down said Bayou to the E. line of the Henry Nichols Survey, A-46;

THENCE Northerly along the Nichols E. line to the NW corner of the Jesse Low Survey, A-147;

THENCE Easterly along the N. line of said Low Survey to its NE corner;

THENCE Southerly along the Jesse Low East line to the NW corner of the G. L. Bourland Beague;

THENCE Easterly along the N line of said Bourland Survey to the NE corner of the same;

THENCE Southerly along its E. line to the Sabine River or Toledo Bend Reservoir;

THENCE Southerly and down said Sabine River or Toledo Bend Reservoir, to the PLACE OF BEGINNING;

This order shall be effective from this date forward.

The above order being read, it was moved by T. A. Seales and seconded by Paul Lout that same pass. Thereupon the question being called for the following members of the Court voted AYE:
