The Court approved the Bond and Oath of Bobby G. White, Justice of the Peace, Pct. # 4, Sabine County, Texas.

Upon the Request of Thomas Hamilton and a motion by Commissioner, R. E. Smith, Seconded by Commissioner, T. A. Seales and by unanimous vote, the Court declared the road which turns off the Springhill road between the residences of Bobby Butler and O. C. Horn and running in a Southeasterly direction to the Nan Clark place to be a County road.

Motion by Commissioner, Paul Lout, seconded by Commissioner, H. E. Wilburn and with all voting "AYE" the court authorized Commissioner, R. E. Smith of Pct. # 1 to advertise the following:

The Commissioners Court of Sabine County will receive bids to 10:00 o'clock A. M. June 26, 1972 at the Court House, Hemphill, Texas, on the following described Road equipment: One Truck Type Loader with not less than 1 1/2 Cu. yard Bucket, with teeth, 4 Cylinder Diesel Engine 72 Net Flywheel Horse Power, 2,100 lbs. weight, Sealed Tracks, Oil Master Clutch, Standard Transmission with 4 Forward and 2 Reversing gears and cab. and offers for trade one used Allis-Chalmers Model HD 6 G Loader. The Court reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
