ORDER DECLARING RESULT OF
LOCAL OPTION ELECTION

On this the 14th day of August, 1972, the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, convened in regular session at the regular meeting place thereof at the Court house in Hemphill, Texas with the following members of the Court present, to-wit:

constituting a quorum, and among other proceedings, passed the following order:

There came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 5th day of August, 1972, in Justice Precinct No. 5, Texas, to determine whether or not the sale of alcoholic beverages of the type specified in the Order calling said election shall be prohibited or legalized.

It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made, and that there were cast at said election 236 valid and legal votes, of which number there were cast

FOR the legal sale of beere 133 votes
AGAINST the legal sale of beer 103 votes

IT IS, THEREFORE, FOUND AND DECLARED AND SO ORDERED by the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas:

That a majority of the qualified voters in said above named area voting at said election voted to LEGALIZE the sale of alcoholic beverages of the type specified in the order calling said election.

This order shall be entered of record in the office of the Clerk of the Court, whereupon it shall be lawful in said above mentioned area to manufacture, sell or distribute alcoholic beverages of the type specified in the order calling said election in accordance with the terms of the Texas Liquor Control Act until such time as the qualified voters of said area may thereafter, at a legal election held for that purpose by a majority vote decide otherwise. The Clerk of this Court shall, within three days from date of this order, certify the results of the above mentioned election to the Secretary of State at Austin, Texas.

The above order being read, it was moved and seconded that same do pass. Thereupon the question being called for, the following members of the Court voted AYE:

A delegation from J. P. Pct. No. 5 headed by Hugh Walker discussed the garbage situation relatively to the recent closing of garbage dumps on U. S. Forest lands in their and asked if County assistance would be available in re-opening these dumps. It was called to the attention of the Court they had applied for and would be given a permit to keep these dumps open until Dec. 31, 1972. The Court explained that there were no funds available for this purpose. The County Judge also explained to this group what was being done concerning a new jail and the repair of the County Courthouse.

Motion by Commissioner, R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner, Paul Lout and by unanimous consent the Court accepted dedication for County use and maintenance by L. C. Hammock three whort roads totaling about 400 yards located in the G. L. Bourland Survey.

Motion by Commissioner, R. E. Smith, seconced by Commissioner, Paul Lout a Plat of LAKE VIEW SHORES SUBDIVISION approved unanimously..

The Court passed an order requesting the Board of County and District Road Indebtedness, State of Texas, Austin, Texas credit Sabine County's share of the lateral road account with \$19,851.78 which represents the County's share of the surplus as of August 31.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
