Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner T. A. Seales and with all voting "AYE" the Court voted to pay \$50.00 more on the Ambulance each month.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn and by unanimous vote the court approved the following Resolution:

On Motion by R. E. Smith and seconded by H. E. Wilburn, the following resolution was adopted:

That the Plat of Lowe's Creek Park Subdivision Number One, which is recorded in Volume 1, Page 115, Plat Records of Sabine County, Texas, contains a specific provision that the roads located in said Subdivision as set forth on the Plat thereof are not dedicated as public roads and are in fact not public roads; That two additional Plats, being a Plat of Lowe's Creek Park No. 2 and Lowe's Creek Park No. 3 are recorded in Volume 1, Page 124, and Volume 1, Page 135, Plat Records of Sabine County, Texas; That these plats do not specifically dedicate the roads shown thereon as public roads,

nor do they specifically state that said roads are not public; That the developer of said subdivision desires a verification from the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, that said roads are not claimed by Sabine County to be public roads; Therefore, be it resolved that the County of Sabine does not now and never has claimed any public interest in the said roads in said subdivision as public roads; and have never maintained the same and have never accepted or contended that said roads were public roads, except that the roads designated as Main Street on the Plat recorded in Volume 1, Page 115, Plat Records of Sabine County, Texas, which road leads from Farm Road No. 83 to the Walter Felts residence is an old County Road and is a public road.

The Court canvassed the Election Returns for the General Election.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
