Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Paul Lout the Court voted to accept the following:

Upon recommendation by the County Clerk, a motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. seconded by Commissioner Paul Lout and by unanimous vote the Court appointed Minnie Gooch to the vacancy created by Corene Todd as Deputy County and District Clerk and also appointed Norma Jean Callis in the position of Assistant County and District Clerk vacated by Minnie Gooch. Both appointments become effective January 31, 1973.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Paul Lout and with all voting "AYE" the Court approved Annual County Budget and Agricultural Extension Work for 1973 to be the same as in 1972 which is:

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn and by unanimous vote the Court directed the Treasurer to transfer the following funds to Officers Salary Fund:

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. and with all voting "AYE" the Court terminated the services of LaNell Short effective January 31, 1973.

Motion by Judge Charlie Forse that the Commissioners strictly keep graders and trucks on County Roads and not be used for driveways or any other purpose except churches and cemeteries. All Commissioners voted no to the above motion.

Motion by Commissioner Paul Lout seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith the Court voted in favor of a motion for the County Clerk to Contact the County Attorney for assistance in cancelling the bond of Henry H. Poindexter and that the Clerk notify Mr. Poindexter by mail of the Courts action. Motion by Commissioner Paul Lout

Recorded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and with all voting "AYE" the Court directed the County Clerk to have the Official Bond and Oath of Henry H. Poindexter cancelled effective January 22, 1973 and that the County Clerk notify Mr. Poindexter in writing of this action. Said Official Bond and Oath being filed in Volume 8, page 173 Official Bond Record Sabine County.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
