On this the 26th day of February, 1973, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in regular session with the following members present, to-wit:

A plat of Mid Lake Village Sub-Division, Section No. 6, was approved by the Court.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn the Court voted to order 4 commode water closet bowls for the County jail.

Motion by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith, the Court voted in favor of purchasing a calculator for the tax-assessor collector office at a price of \$450.00.

The Clerk of Court was directed to advertise for bids on gasoline and related petroleum products used by the County.

Motion by Commissioner, G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn the Court voted unanimously to keep the rest rooms in the Court House open Saturdays until 5:00 P. M.

Motion by Commissioner, H. E. Wilburn, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and all voting "AYE" the Court employed T. A. Seales as Special Deputy Sheriff and Pound Master for Sabine County at a salary of \$360.00 per month effective March 1, 1973,

and the Clerk was directed to publish such notice in a newspaper.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith, the Court voted unanimously to exempt \$3000.00 of the value of residence homesteads of all persons sixty-five years of age or older from ad valorem taxes.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.

The following resolution was adopted by the Court.

A regular meeting of the Sabine County Commissioners' Court was held on the 26th day of February, 1973, at 10 o'clock A.M. at the Sabine County Court Building located in Hemphill, Sabine County, Texas.

The meeting was called by Judge Charles Forse for the purpose of adopting a Resolution for support of a proposed route of the EAST TEXAS PARKWAY.

The following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the County of Sabine desires and endeavors to participate in all progressive activities conducive to the economic development of the State, area, community, and its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Sabine is a member of the EAST TEXAS PARKWAY ASSOCIATION, an organization created for the purpose of promoting a main thoroughfare through EAST TEXAS for the economic benefit of the area; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed route of the EAST TEXAS PARKWAY shall pass through Sabine County; and,

WHEREAS, the said EAST TEXAS PARKWAY shall improve the economic development of the State, area, county, and its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the EAST TEXAS PARKWAY ASSOCIATION has a meeting with the Texas Highway Department for Thursday, March 1, 1973, at 9:00 o'clock A.M., at the Texas Highway Department Building in Austin, Texas. The meeting being for the purpose of either extending or redesignating U. S. Highway 96, along the route of Highways 62, 96, 149, and 259 and naming the route the EAST TEXAS PARKWAY; and

RESOLVED, that the County of Sabine support the proposed route of the EAST TEXAS PARKWAY, and more particularly the extension or redesignation of U. S. Highway 96, along the route of Highways 62, 96, 59, 149, and 259 and naming the route EAST TEXAS PARKWAY.

On motion duly made and carried, the meeting adjourned.
