On this the 23rd day of April, 1973, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in regular session with the following members present, to-wit:

61 Motion by Commissioner, G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn, the Court voted unanimously to appropriate \$450.00 to install tile floors on three rooms in the County jail.

95 Motion by Commissioner Paul Lout, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith, Returns of Election For County School Trustees were approved and ordered filed in the Record of Election Returns.

97 Official Bond & Oath of T. A. Seales, Special Deputy Sheriff and Pound Master was approved by the Court.

92 A hearing, which was scheduled at the last regular meeting of the Court, was held concerning an old road in the Moses Hill Survey of Sabine County. The road was alleged to have been from near the Andrew J. Tucker place in a northwesterly direction through what is now known as Harbor Light Subdivision to the old Sidney McClanahan home place and on to Rocky Ford on Palo Goucho Bayou. Parties to the hearing were W. T. Shirley, represented by Attorney Macon Strother and Douglas Haygood represented by Attorney Allen Weed. After hearing testimony of Mrs. Nettie King, W. A. Norsworthy, C. A. Bragg, Irona Davidson, Mary Bragg and Douglas Haygood and arguments by the attorneys, motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Paul Lout and with all voting "AYE", the Court ruled the road to be a county road available for public use.

Attorney Allen Weed filed the following exception:
Exception to action of Commission because no formal application has been filed in accordance with state law and statutory requirements; and that no metes and bounds description of the purported road has been presented to the Commission; and that no action in regard to this purported road is declared; and that the action of the Commission in determining a county road or not is not within the jurisdiction of the Commissioners Court.

48 The Court directed the County Treasurer to transfer the following amounts to Officer Salary Fund:

General County Fund----- \$ 1,184.39

Road & Bridge Special Fund ----- \$38,622.32

29 The Court further directed the County Treasurer to divide equally the remainder of Road & Bridge Special Fund between the four commissioner precincts on a basis of 25% to each precinct.

97 The Court authorized a refund of \$25.00 to T. A. Seales for trailer hire used in the course of his duties as Special Deputy Sheriff and Pound Master.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
