R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the County of Sabine is in full support of the rehabilitation of D.W.I. Probationers and has experienced problems in this regard, and,

WHEREAS, it is found that the Deep East Texas Council of Governments is attempting to provide needed services by use of funds available through the Texas Criminal Justice Council by obtaining a grant therefrom. The Commissioners Court being in favor of such services and such grant for use in rehabilitation, and,

WHEREAS, the County of Sabine will contribute to said grant as stated in Exhibit "A" attached to and now a part of this resolution, and,

WHEREAS, such services as to be provided by the Deep East Texas Council of Governments to the County of Sabine are as follows:

- A. Psychological evaluation of the 1st offender DWI 's.
- B. Alcohol education for general public including court classes for 1st offender DWI's.
- C. Referral to other agencies.

The County of Sabine agrees to provide the following in support of the Regional DWI Court Classes Project:

- (1) 300 square feet of classroom space which will be used for four (4) consecutive evenings one (1) week a month for three (3) years.
- (2) Janitorial and utilities cost for the classroom and office space.
- (3) One (1) desk.
- (4) Two (2) chairs.
- (5) One (1) lamp.
- (6) 150 square feet of office space, five (5) days a week for one (1) year.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.
