The Clerk of Court was directed to file the petition, check the names of the petitioners for correctness and return at the next regular meeting of the Court.

Mrs. T. V. Parke^{of} and a group/interested citizens of Sabine County appeared before the Court in an appeal to get something done about the poor condition of the County Courthouse. They requested that some of the Federal Revenue Sharing Funds be used for this purpose and pleaded with the Court to start a fund to recondition the courthouse. Since all members of the Court were not present, no action was to be taken until the next term of Court.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to pay Henry C. Powell, Justice of the Peace, Precinct #5 a salary was tabled without being seconded. It was learned

that Henry C. Powell had not completed schooling as required by law.

Ray Faircloth of Sabine Investment Company requested the Commissioners Court to accept the roads in El Camino Subdivision for county maintenance.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn, the Court voted unanimously to accept the roads in El Camino Subdivision for maintenance.

Motion by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. and all voting AYE, the Court approved a plat of Mason Creek Subdivision No. 1.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
