Certification of County Clerk pertaining to petition to call special election for Mayor and City Councilmen of Bronson, Texas.

I, the undersigned County Clerk of Sabine County, Texas, do hereby certify that I have checked the Petition To Call Special Election For Mayor and City Councilmen of Bronson, Texas Election and filed with me on the 11th day of June, 1973, and requesting that a special election be held in accordance with the terms and provisions of Article 990, Vernon's Annotated Statutes, in Bronson, Texas, (said County, Justice Precinct, Incorporated City or Town hereinafter for convenience referred to as Area), and I hereby certify as follows pertaining to said petitions:

1. That said petitions were filed with me on the 11th day of June, 1973, which is within 30 days after the date of issuance of said petitions.
2. That in checking the names of the signers of said petitions to ascertain the number of qualified voters signing said petitions no signature was counted where there was reason to believe that the signature was not the actual signature of the purported signer or that said signature is a duplicate either of name or handwriting used in any other signature on said petitions and no signature was counted unless the resident address of the signer is shown or unless it is signed exactly as the signer's name appears on the official copy of the current list of registered voters for the voting year for which the petition is issued.

A delegation headed by Mrs. T. V. Parker, Sam Malone, met with the Court and again expressed their willingness to assist in planning a working toward the repair of the County Courthouse as well as other County projects.

McNeil Adams of the Deep East Texas Council on Government addressed the Court concerning repair of the Courthouse, Federal Revenue Sharing Fund, Solid Waste and the Regional Bi-Centennial Exposition. He stated that Sabine County had been redesignated and is now eligible for assistance from the Economical Development Association and that Sabine County could make a pre-application for funds at a conference to be held on July 16, 1973. Sabine County could possibly receive a 60% grant from the application and would have to pay 40% from County Funds. Twenty-one days after the July 16 conference, a definite decision would be made on this matter. The Court arranged a meeting with Mr. Adams for Friday, June 29 at 2:00 P. M. to commence a study of County programs and problems.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn, the Court voted in favor of paying \$300.00 dues to Deep East Texas Council of Government Economic Development District for period July 1, 1973 through June 30, 1974.

All accounts allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
