John Sutton petitioned the Court to install 2 cattleguards on a third class road. Cattle guards would be furnished by Mr. Sutton or donated to the County. The Court declared that it had already ruled on this matter on the 27th day of March, 1972 and declared it would stand *on* its decision of that date, where, on a Motion by Commissioner Paul Lout, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith that the dirt road in the J. S. Lane Survey leading off Highway 87 and running in a southeasterly direction through the Jesse Moody place to the John Battle place be declared a third class county road. Voting for the motion were Commissioner Paul Lout and Commissioner R. E. Smith. Voting against the motion were Commissioner T. A. Seales and Commissioner H. E. Wilburn. Since the voting was tied two for and two against, the County Judge broke the tie by voting for the motion. The County Judge pointed out that any land owner on this road who wanted cattle guards where stock gaps are located could install a suitable iron cattle guard at his own expense."

A Bond for John A. McGee, as Public Weigher was approved by the Court.

Robert Gene McDaniel, Deputy Sheriff, requested a leave of absence from the county due to illness. On motion by Commissioner Paul Lout, seconded by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn and all voting "AYE", the Court voted for the leave of absence without pay for an indefinite period of time.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
