Smith, and by unanimous vote, John Oliver was appointed Deputy Sheriff Sabine County, Texas, effective May 1, 1974 at a salary of \$323.00 per month, expenses of \$250.00 per month, and the usual monetary benefits accorded other county employees; said salary, expenses and monetary benefits to be divided equally between the City of Hemphill, Texas and Sabine County, Texas.

Accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
