The Court directed the Clerk of Court to forward the petition to Texas Highway Department, Lufkin, Texas for their consideration.

Herbert Ladner requested permission from the Court to allow him to install a cattle guard on the county road leading off Forest Road 128 to Indian Mounds Subdivision. The cattle guard was to be constructed of iron and be at least 14 feet wide.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr, and by unanimous vote, permission to install the cattle guard at no expense to the County was granted.

Motion by Commissioner Paul Lout, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and with all voting "AYE", the Court passed an order requesting the Board of County and District Road Indebtedness, State of Texas, Austin, Texas to credit the Sabine County Lateral Road Account with \$19,851.78 which represents the county's share of the surplus as of August 31, and which is to be used for construction or improvement of Sabine county lateral roads.

Motion by Commissioner Paul Lout, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and by unanimous vote, the Court directed that the Treasurer credit the accounts of the various funds with funds received from the Offices of Emergency Preparedness according to their summary of amounts approved and claimed as follows:

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1 Road & Bridge Fund No. 1-----\$1,117.18

5 Road & Bridge Fund No. 3-----\$2,110.04

4 Road & Bridge Fund No. 4------ \$ 680.22

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn and with all voting "AYE" the Court directed the Treasurer to prorate the Federal Revenue Sharing Funds in the amount of \$46,227.00 as follows:
