Motion by Commissioner Paul Lout, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith, and with all voting in favor of the motion to authorize the County Clerk to employ a substitute clerk during the absence of Deputy Clerk Minnie Gooch. Salary was set at \$1.90 per hour.

Motion by Commissioner Paul Lout, seconded by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn and by unanimous vote, the Court directed the Tax Assessor-Collector to prepare a list of taxpayers and the amount of money to be refunded them for homestead exemption, and the County Clerk would be authorized to issue a warrant to the taxpayer to cover this refund.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner H. E. Wilburn and all voted in favor of the motion to employ D. B. Speights, Sr. as appraiser and negotiator for the Right of Way for Farm Road No. 3315.

Returns of the General Election held on November 5, 1974 were canvassed and approved and ordered filed. All accounts were allowed and made payable. There being no further business the Court adjourned.
