COMMISSIONERS COURT MEETING

December 23, 1974

A regular meeting of the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, was held on the 23rd day of December, 1974, at 8:30 A. M. at the courthouse in Hemphill, Texas.

The meeting was called by County Judge Charlie Forse for the purpose of adopting a Resolution supporting the proposed creation of a HOSPITAL DISTRICT, for Sabine County, Texas.

The following Resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, in the interest of the Economic Welfare
and Health, of the Citizens of Sabine County, Texas,

who have expressed to this Court their interest and desire in the creation of a HOSPITAL DISTRICT, or hospital facilities in Sabine County.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Judge and the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, hereby supports the creation of a COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT, encompassing the borders of the entire County of Sabine, and hereby solicit the support of the Legislature of the State of Texas in the creation of the said COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT.

On motion duly made and seconded, the Resolution was adopted unanimously.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO APPLY FOR AN ACT
CREATING THE SABINE COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT
OVER ALL OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS

TO THE RESIDENTS OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS,
AND ALL OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that after due publication hereof, the undersigned intend to apply to the Texas Legislature at its regular session in 1975 for the passage of an Act authorizing the creation of a Hospital District over all of Sabine County, Texas, under the authority granted by Article IX, Section 9, of the Texas Constitution, the general purposes and nature of such Act being expressed as follows:

"AN ACT providing for the creation of the Sabine County Hospital District over all of Sabine County, Texas; providing that the District shall assume any outstanding debt of Sabine County incurred for hospital purposes and any outstanding debt incurred by any city or town within said County for such purpose; prescribing a procedure for an election on the creation of such District and the levy of a tax in an amount not to exceed Seventy-five cents (75¢) on the \$100 valuation for its maintenance, support, and payment of indebtedness; providing the powers of the District and its governing body and its procedures in the governing of said District; enacting other provisions incident and related to the subject and purposes; providing a severance clause; and declaring an emergency."
