Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. and by unanimous consent the County Depository Pledge Contract for County and School Funds, which had previously been awarded to First State Bank, Hemphill, Texas was approved by the Court.

Motion by Commissioner Paul Lout, seconded by Commissioner R. W. Smith and with all voting in favor of the motion, Commissioner Precinct No. 4 was authorized to request bids for a reconditioned model 118 Gallion Maintainer with cab, heater, and four new tires.

Motion by Commissioner Paul Lout, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and by unanimous vote the Court withdrew Sabine County from the Mental Health and Retardation Service which had previously been conditionally approved September 23, 1974.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell Jr., seconded by Commissioner Paul Lout and with all concurring the Court affirmed that the portion of a road on the north side of the unrecorded Kim Kove subdivision and immediately adjacent to property purchased by Vernon Rudd from H. W. Smith by Quit Claim deed on 2-26-75 was not a county road.
