Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell and by unanimous vote, the Court approved a plat of Mason Creed Subdivision.

Royce Smith of the Sabine Insurance Company discussed the annual audit of Workmans Compensation Insurance and General Libality Insurance which amounted to \$2,021.00.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and with all voting "AYE", the Clerk was directed to pay the \$2,121.00 and prorate the amount between the various funds according to their participation.

B. F. Whitworth, A. W. Davis, and Howard Montgomery appeared before the Court connerning roads in the Springhill Subdivision. It was pointed out that since Springhill Subdivision was developed in 1968 and that the Rules Governing Subdivisions were not adopted by the Court until 1971, that they were asking a waiver of the requirement that the crown of the roads in this development be lowered from 24 feet to 16 or 18 feet and that the cul-de-sac on dead end roads in this subdivision be narrowed from the required 40 feet radius to approximately 20 or 25 feet radius. It was the opinion of Commissioner G. W. Russell, $J_{\mathbf{r}}$, that the rules governing the subdivisions not be altered in this case. It was agreed that the owners of the development would write up specifications on the road and submit them to the Court for approval. It was the desire of the woners of the subdivision to turn these roads over to the County for maintenance.

All accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no furthur business, the Court adjourned.

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
