Motion by Commissioner Paul Lout seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. and by unanimous vote, the Court continued the employment of Arthur Seales as Deputy Pound Master through September 30, 1975.

Motion by Commissioner Paul Lout, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and with all voting "AYE", the Court adopted the following resolution:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Federal-Aid Highway Act of 1973 calls for a realignment of the Federal-Aid Primary, Secondary and Urban Systems to be completed by June 30, 1976 and,

WHEREAS, the routes of the Federal-Aid Primary System shall be designated by each State acting through its State Highway department, and,

WHEREAS, the routes of the Federal-Aid Secondary System shall be designated by each state acting through its State highway department and appropriate local officials in cooperation with each other, and,

WHEREAS, this Court, being the appropriate local government agency and having exercised its jurisdiction indicated above, does, therefore,

Resolve that all areas of responsibility involving this agency and the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation have been satisfactorily complied with, do hereby indicate approval of the realigned Federal-Aid Primary and Federal-Aid Secondary System reviewed and recommended this date.

- \$8615.32 General Fund
- \$1384.68 Officer Salary Fund for the three months salary of Deputy Pound Master Arthur Seales through September 30, 1975.
