RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Federal-Aid $^{\mathrm{H}}$ ighway Act of 1973 calls for a realignment of the Federal-Aid Primary, Secondary and Urban Systems to be completed by June 30, 1976

WHEREAS, the routes of the Federal-Aid Primary System shall be designated by each State acting through its State Highway department, and,

WHEREAS, the routes of the Federal-Aid Secondary System shall be designated by each state acting through its State highway department and appropriate local officials in cooperation with each other, and,

WHEREAS, this Court, being the appropriate local government agency and having exercised its jurisdiction indicated above, does, therefore,

Resolve that all areas of responsibility involving this agency and the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation have been satisfactorily complied with, do hereby indicate approval of the realigned Federal-Aid Primary and Federal-Aid Secondary System reviewed and recommended this date.

The Court authorized the County Judge to look for a future site for a new County Jail.

The Clerk of Court was directed to write a letter to L. A. Fullen concerning removing his fence on the road right-of-way of FM. 3315 now being constructed and have the letter delivered to Mr. Fullen by the Sheriff of Sabines County.

All accounts were allowed and made Payable.

There being no furthur business, the Court adjourned.
