Motion by Commissioner Paul Lout, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith, the Court voted unanimously to divide County ad valorem taxes as follows:

10/16 General Fund
3/16 Road & Bridge Fund
2/16 Permanent Improvement Fund
1/16 Jury Fund




All accounts were allowed and made payable.
