PETITION TO CALL HOSPITAL DISTRICT ELECTION

We, the undersigned, being qualified voters of Sabine County, Texas, pursuant to the provisions of House Bill No. 1333 enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas to take effect September 1, 1975, do hereby petition the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas to order an election to approve the creation of the Sabine County Hospital District and to elect a Board of Directors of Said Hospital District. We further request the Commissioners Court to also order an election to determine whether the district may levy taxes within the district.

No. 1333, it is accordingly ordered that a SPECIAL ELECTION be held contemporaneously with the General Election on Tuesday, the 4th day of November, 1975, for the purpose of voting on the following:

"FOR THE CREATION OF SABINE COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS",
" AGAINST THE CREATION OF SABINE COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS",
And to elect five (5) directors to manage and control the Sabine County District of Sabine County, Texas. There will be one director elected from each precinct and one director elected at large.

We, the undersigned, being resident citizens and qualified voters of Sabine County, Texas, do hereby petition the Legislature of the State of Texas by and through our duly authorized Legislative Representatives, the Honorable Buddy Temple and the Honorable Don Adams, to pass the necessary legislation to include Sabine County, Texas under and subject to the provisions of the Uniform Wildlife Regulatory Act of the State of Texas, thus placing Sabine County, Texas under the regulatory authority of the Parks and Wildlife Department of the State of Texas.

"AGAINST PLACING SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS UNDER THE REGULATORY AUTHORITY OF THE PARKS AND WILDLIFE DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE OF TEXAS."

The election judges and polling places will be the same as those designated for the Constitutional Amendment election, the Special Election for or against the creation of Sabine County Hospital District of Sabine County, Texas and the Special Election to elect.
