Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and by unanimous vote, the Charlie Honeycutt road in Precinct No. 2, leading off of Forest Service Road No. 115, was accepted for County maintenance.

By consent and on a motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers and with all voting "AYE", the Court directed the County Treasurer to transfer \$5,000.00 from R & B Fund #1 Revenue Sharing to General County Revenue Sharing Fund with the understanding this money would be refunded by the General County Fund when the money becomes available.

Motion by G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, and by unanimous consent the returns of the elections held on November 4, 1975, which were canvassed by the Court, were held to be in order and the following order was passed:

constituting a quorum, and among other proceedings passed the following order:

There came on to be considered the returns of a Special Election held on the 4th day of November, 1975 in Sabine County, Texas, upon the proposition as set forth in the Order of Special Election calling said election and it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made, and there were cast at said election:

IT IS THEREFORE FOUND, DECLARED AND SO ORDERED by the Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, Texas, that a majority voting at said election, voted in favor of the proposition "FOR" THE CREATION OF SABINE COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS, and that therefore said proposition as set out in the Order of Special Election adopted by this Court is declared to have been passed; that a majority voting at said election failed to vote for the proposition "FOR" PLACING SABINE COUNTY UNDER THE REGULATORY AUTHORITY OF THE PARKS AND WILDLIFE DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, AND THEREFORE said proposition as set out in the Order of Special Election adopted by this Court is declared to have failed; that a majority voting at said election for Directors of Sabine County Hospital District voted in favor of James R. Young, Director-at-large; L.H. Adickes, Director, Precinct No. 1; Elton A Mayfield, Director, Precinct No. 2; Hollis B. Ellison, Director, Precinct No. 3; and H. J. Vickers, Director, Precinct No. 4.

It is further found and determined that written notice of the date, place and subject of this meeting was posted as required by Article 6252-17 and that all terms of provisions of said article have been fully met and complied with.

The above order being read, it was moved and seconded that same do pass. Thereupon, the question being called for, the following members of the Court voted AYE: R. E. Smith, Commissioner, Precinct No. 1; G. W. Russell, Jr., Commissioner, Precinct No. 2; Paul Lout, Commissioner, Precinct No. 3 and Jimmy Vickers, Commissioner Precinct No. 4. The following voted NO:
