Carl E. Smith, Tax Assessor-Collector, Sabine County Texas, presented the following letter to the Court:

Motion by Comm. G.W. Russell Jr., seconded by Comm.R.E. Smith and by unanimous vote the resignation of Carl E. Smith, Tax Assessor-Collector, was accepted by the Court effective January 1, 1976.

Motion by Commissioner G.W. Russell Jr. seconded by Commissioner Paul Lout and with all voting "aye" the Court appointed Marie White to the office of Tax Assessor-collector, Sabine County Texas, effective January 1, 1976, to serve the unexpired term of Carl E. Smith.

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The Court directed that Carl E. Smith, be paid his salary for the month of January 1976 since he would have to be present during this month while transferring the records of the office to the incoming Tax Assessor-Collector.

At the request of Frank Rash, on a motion by Commissioner G.W. Russell, Jr. seconded by Commissioner Paul Lout the Court authorized Sarah Jacks be employed five days each week in the office of Justice of the Peace, Precinct No.1, effective, January 1, 1975.

The following resolution was presented to the Court.

MINUTE ORDER

Sabine County

In Sabine County a Farm to Market Road is hereby designated extending from end of Farm to Market Road 3315, 4.1 miles East of State Highway 87, Southeast a distance of approximately 0.9 mile, subject to the conditions that Sabine County will furnish all required right of way clear of obstructions and free of cost to the State and acquisition procedures will be in accordance with applicable Federal and State laws governing the acquisition policies for acquiring real property.


At such time as the County shall accept the provision of this Order and agree to the furnishing of the required right of way, the Engineer-Director is directed to proceed with the engineering development, Relocation Assistance at an estimated cost of \$200, and construction of the project in the most feasible and economical manner at an

estimated cost of \$164,000 as authorized in the 1975 Texas Farm to Market Road and OFF System Roads Program, and to assume the road for State maintenance upon completion of the construction.

This Order is subject to acceptance by the County and if not accepted within 90 days of the date hereof, the action herein contained shall be automatically cancelled.


All accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the Court adjourned
