Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and with all voting in favor of the motion, the Bond and Oath of Leon G. Finklea, Deputy Pound Master, was approved by the Court.

A certificate of the County Clerk pertaining to Petition For Local Option Election in Justice Precinct No. 2 was examined by the Court and upon finding the petitions did not meet the requirements for Local Option Election, motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner Paul Lout and with all voting "AYE", Petition For Local Option Election To Legalize in Justice Precinct No. 2 was denied by the Court. The above certificate of the County Clerk is attached to the minutes of this date, marked Exhibit A and becomes a part of the minutes.

Sam S. Bates and Don Cole, representing Prindle, Patrick and Partners, Architects, Engineers, Planners and Jail Specialists, discussed Phase I of a feasibility study for a jail in Sabine County. The firm requested that they be considered to make the Phase I study and eventually carry it on through Phase II and Phase III. No action was taken on this matter by the Court.

I, the undersigned County Clerk of Sabine County, Texas,
do hereby certify that I have checked the original and copy of Petition for Local Option Election
to Legalize, Serial Number 1, issued the 2nd day of March,
(Legalize or Prohibit)
1976, and all filed with me on the 1st day of April, 1976, and requesting
that a local option election be held in accordance with the terms and provisions of Article 666-32
through 666-40a of Vernon's Annotated Penal Code of the State of Texas, as amended, in _____
Justice Precinct No. 2, Texas, (said County, Justice Precinct,
(County, Justice Precinct, Incorporated City or Town)
Incorporated City or Town hereinafter for convenience referred to as Area), and I hereby certify as
follows pertaining to said petitions:

1. That said petitions were filed with me on the 1st day of April, 1976,
which is within 30 days after the date of issuance of said petitions.


2. That in checking the names of the signers of said petitions to ascertain the number of qualified
voters signing said petitions no signature was counted where there was reason to believe that the sig-
nature was not the actual signature of the purported signer or that said signature is a duplicate either
of name or handwriting used in any other signature on said petitions and no signature was counted
unless the resident address of the signer is shown or unless it is signed exactly as the signer's name
appears on the official copy of the current list of registered voters for the voting year for which the petition
is issued.

3. I further certify that said petitions are signed in accordance with the above requirements by
less than 35% ~~25%~~ of the qualified voters at the time said petitions were issued in
(as many as or less than)
said Area taking the votes for Governor at the last preceding general election at which presidential elec-
tors were elected as the basis for determining the qualified voters in said Area.

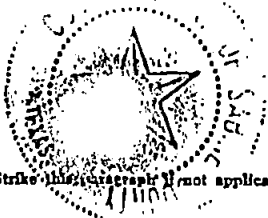
4. I further certify that said petitions were in accordance with the above requirements and were
