COUNTY OF SABINE

On this the 24th day of January, 1977, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in Regular session with the following present, to-wit:

The Court directed that A. G. Smith replace J. S. Marcantel as presiding Judge in Election Precinct No. 9, Bronson, Texas.

In compliance with House Bill No. 384, the following public members of the Grievance Committee for Sabine County was drawn as required by law: T. A. Seales, Paul Seago, and Amos B. Anderson.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Jimmy R. Vickers and with all voting "Aye", effective February 1, 1977, Sabine County will pay all of Deputy Sheriff James D. Walker's salary and expenses heretofore shared with the City of Hemphill.

The Court appointed a Canvas Board for the Special Election to be held February 5, 1977 to be composed of Minnie Gooch, presiding judge and Gayle Leone and Peggy Powell, election clerks.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and by unanimous vote, the Court granted an increase of 10 cents per meal for prisoners fed in the County Jail.

The Court directed the Clerk of the Court to advertise for Gasoline, Diesel Fuel and Fuel Oil needs for Sabine County for the year 1977. Said bids to be in the County Judge's office by 10 A.M. February 5, 1977.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Jimmy R. Vickers the Court voted unanimously to divide the Federal Revenue Sharing in the amount of \$20,433.00 as follows: \$4,040.00 Salary and Expenses of Deputy Pound Master and the remainder of \$16,393.00 to be divided equally between the four Commissioner Precincts.

At the request of Mayor C. C. Rice of the City of Hemphill, to conserve natural gas due to the current shortage, on a motion by Commissioner Jimmy R. Vickers, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison and with all voting in favor the Court agreed to open the Courthouse at 9:00 A. M. and cut off the gas heaters at 3:00 P. M.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Jimmy R. Vickers and by unanimous vote the Court approved a plat of the PINE RIDGE SUBDIVISION, said Subdivision to have private streets.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison and with all voting "Aye", the Court declined turning certain old records over to the Texas State Archives.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Jimmy R. Vickers and by unanimous consent, the Court authorized the construction of a Domino Hall by B. B. Jones under the Courthouse steps to be financed by the Domino Players.






