On this the 11th day of April, 1977, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in regular session with the following present, to-wit:

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison the Court voted as follows to keep all the County Courthouse offices open until 12:00 o'clock noon on Saturdays not to exceed 40 hours a week: Voting for the motion were Commissioners G. W. Russell, Jr., R. E. Smith and Eldridge Ellison. Voting against the motion was Commissioner Jimmy R. Vickers.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Eldridge Ellison and with all voting "Aye" the Court voted to pay Minnie Ponder, Dispatcher in the Sheriff's office a salary of \$438.43 and Expenses \$98.00 .

The Court authorized the Sheriff to install radios in cars belonging to Constables John Wheat and Robert G. McDaniel.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith the Court approved the following resolution:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, SABINE County, being duly constituted member of the Deep East Texas Council of Governments and desirous of participation in those decisions affecting this Region, and

WHEREAS, we recognize the need for low income rental housing subsidies in this County, and throughout the Region, of the type and nature defined in the H.U.D. Section 8 Housing Assistance Programs, and

WHEREAS, we feel that these needs, which are common to the Region generally, can best be addressed by a Regional approach to this problem.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The County Judge of Sabine County is authorized to concur with, and to instruct in its behalf, the Deep East Texas Council of Governments to take those actions and/or decisions that would result in:

The award by H.U.D., to The Deep East Texas Council of Governments: Human Resources Division; those designations, resources and assistance that would enable them to properly initiate and administrate the Section 8 Housing Assistance Programs on a Regional basis.
