Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, Seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison and unanimous consent of the court the following Resolution was approved:

RESOLUTION

Where as the Commissioners Court of Sabine County recognizes the need to improve correctional facilities and services in Sabine County and a correctional study has been completed detailing these needs.

The County is hereby resolved to support the application to the Texas Governors Office, Criminal Justice Division for a Phase II planning grant to fund working drawings and bid documents along with related endeavors.

The Court intends to pursue construction of the facility through the issuance of bonds and will call an election for that purpose.

Collector agrees and binds himself and his successors in office to give expeditious attention to examination and approval of the record and to pay to Contractor upon completion, delivery and approval of the delinquent tax record supplement herein provided for and approval of the account for compiling the record the total sum for said record; to-wit: Twenty (20) cents per item or written line, including lines of footings and recapitulation, shown on the original copy of the record. Said payment to be made in the manner and as is provided by Article 7336f, Vernon's Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, as amended HB 302 Acts of 62nd Legislature Regular Session 1971.

This contract includes the year 1975 which taxes are not now delinquent. It is agreed and understood that the compilation will not be completed until after the 1975 taxes are reported delinquent as of June 30, 1976.

Contractor agrees and binds, itself that for and inconsideration of the price stated herein to do, at its own proper cost and expense, all the work necessary, to furnish all the supplies, materials, and equipment required to compile the delinquent tax record supplement for Sabine County, Texas for the years 1969 to 1975 both inclusive.
