Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and by unanimous consent the court gave a 15% raise in salary to all county employees, June 1, 1978.

Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., and by unanimous consent the court declared the old Baldree road in Commissioner Precinct No. 4 to be a County Road.

Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison ; and by unanimous consent the court directed letters be written to Representative Arthur (Buddy) Temple, U. S. Senator Lloyd Bentsen, Jr. and U. S. Representative Charles Wilson, stating that the court oppose any and all proposed designated Wilderness Areas in SabineCounty.

Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and by unanimous consent the court authorized Commissioner of Pct. #3 to advertise for bids for a used crawler type loader with a used loader as a trade-in. Bids to be opened July 10th at the Commissioners Court meeting.

Accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the Court adjourned.
