
B. B. Jones appeared before the Court with the following petition:

We are each satisfied with the present laws for hunting and fishing as they apply to Sabine County, Texas. signed by 1221 persons

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison and with all voting "Aye" the court recognized the petition with 1221 names.

Accounts were allowed and made payable.
