Carmichael appeared before the court. Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, that the portable Radar Unit at the discretion of the Sheriff can be used by the Constables of the various J. P. Precincts.

Second was made by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. and all voted in favor of the motion.

List of Books and supplies needed for Justice of the Peace office was read. Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to order these supplies. All voted in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to pay Justice of the Peace in Pct. #2 and Pct. #5 a salary of \$100.00 per month effective January 1, 1979. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. for Constable in J. P. Pct. #2 to begin with a salary of \$31.62. All voted in favor of the motion.

Upon a recommendation by J. P. Richard Bass, motion was made by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers to hire Miss Willie Ragan as secretary to that office at a salary of \$463.32, effective January 1, 1979. Seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and all voted in favor.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison that Officers of Sabine County be compensated on a salary basis for the year 1979. All voted in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison and seconded by
Commissioner R. E. Smith and with all voting "Aye" the Budget for
County Agent was approved as follows: \$232.76 salary, ^{monthly} \$41.66 expenses
and \$500.00 for supplies and telephone for the year.

Accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the court adjourned.
