Lynda Melton with Blue Cross Blue Sheild appeared before the court to explain provisions of our policy. Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vichers seconded by Commissioner R.E. Smith and by unanimous consent of the court the following change was made in our policy to become effective Aug. 1st, 1979:

- 1. That it be \$200.00 Deductable instead of \$100.00.
- 2. That we drop the disability.
- 3. That Dental Provision be added.
- 4. Premiums be lowered as follows:

From 36.50 to 30.87 employee
From 43.84 to 39.99 for 1 dependent
From 54.23 to 50.92 for 2 or more dependents

Upon a motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and with all voting in favor the following Resolution was passed by the court:

In reguard to the new Tax Relief and Reform being House Bill # 1066 and Senate Bill # 621; due to the fact that on or about the time the bills were signed into law Sabine County had already been sworn in as a Board of Equalization on May 14th and grivances days had been set for June 12th and 13th, the Court passed this resolution to leavethe tax as is for this year and to comply with such law for 1980.

Motion was made by Commissioner R. E. Smith seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison and by unanimous consent of the court a resolution was passed as being in favor of the state placing and maintaining a Tourist Guide in the County.

A motion was made by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison seconed by Commissioner R. E. Smith to invite the Comptroller of Public Accounts to meet with the court about booking and budgeting for the county. All voted in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith seconed by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers and with all voting "Aye" the Court divided the following money in the usual way. R & B Tax in the amount of \$8,522.19 and R. & B. Speciel in the amount of \$3,302.10.

Upon a Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith seconed by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers and by unanimous consent the court elected Judge Royce C. Smith as Board member of the 1980 Regional Aging Advisory of the Council of Governments.

Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to give all County employes and elected officials a 5 % raise in salary. The motion carried.

Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. made a motion that the new Farm to Market Road into old Sabinetown follow the blue line or line B as appeares on Texas Hwy. Dept. map. Commissioner Eldridge Ellison seconded All voting yes.

Accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no futher business, the Court adjourned.
