Juvenile Probation Officer Richard Drake telephoned Judge Smith and said that Jasper County was unable to fund the Juvenile Probation program, and was not sure about the other counties. Commissioners discussed this issue, and stated that Sabine County could not fund the program especially if the other counties didn't.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to take care of the following items concerning Jail standards.

- #1 No voice communication between inmates and custodial personal.
- #12 No automatic fire alarms or smoke detectors.
- #13 No smoke and fume removal system.

With all voting in favor the Motion was carried.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison for Corp of Engineers to give County the right of way located in Tract 1115, Sam Rayburn Reservoir. See "Exhibit A" attached.

Representing The Corp of Engineers was Mr. Lloyd Conn. The motion was carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison and all voting in favor the Road & Bridge Special money in the amount of \$11,691.69 was divided as follows.

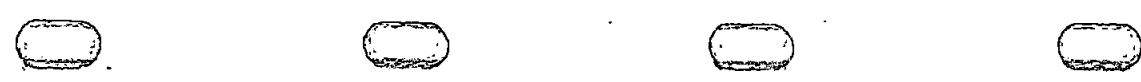

CENTERLINE DESCRIPTION

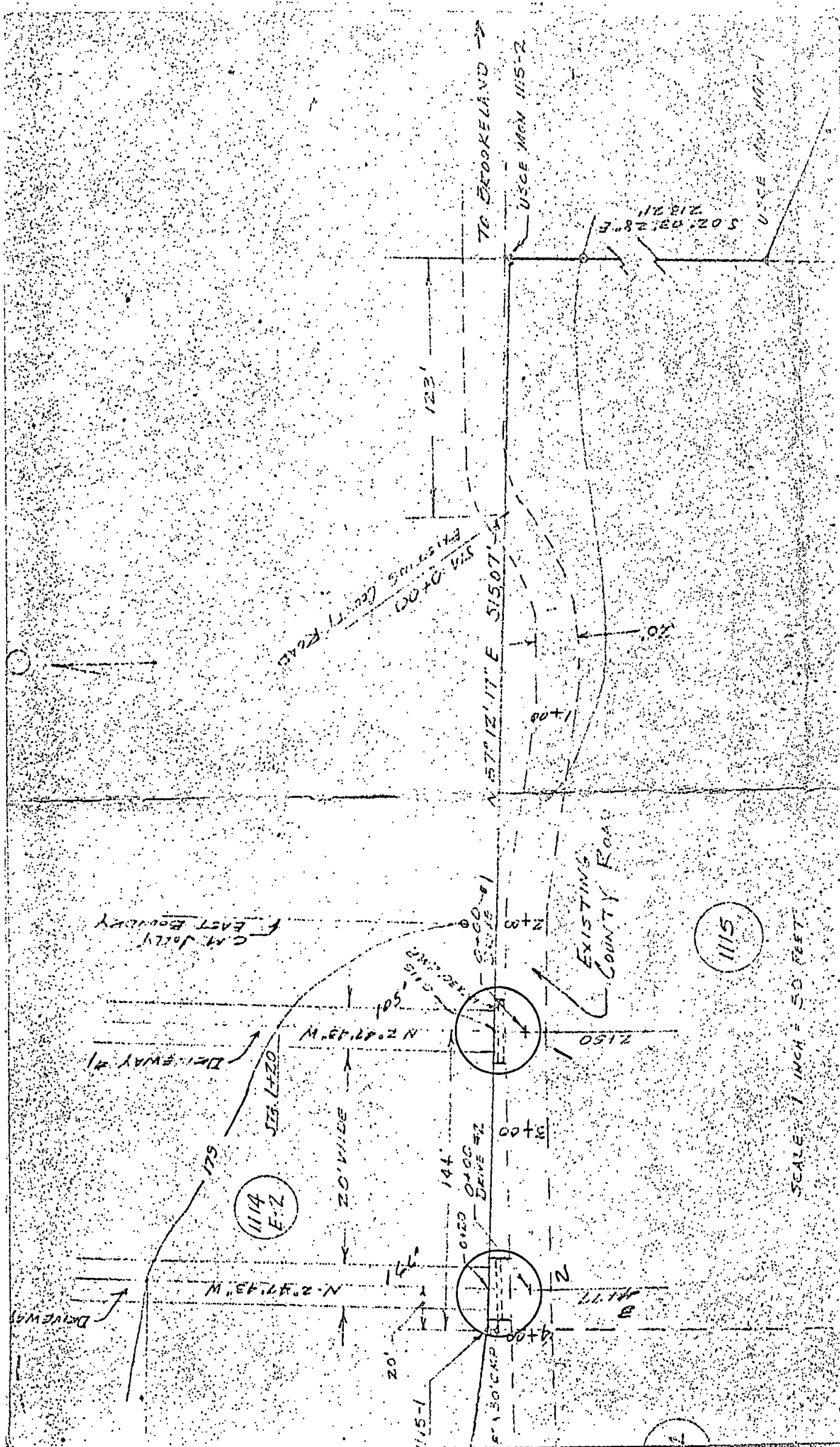
Proposed Easement - Tract 1115
Sam Rayburn Reservoir

The following describes the centerline of two proposed driveway easements, each 30 feet in width, across U. S. Government owned land in Sabine County, Texas, and more specifically located in Tract 1115, Sam Rayburn Reservoir.

Drive No. 1 - From U. S. Corps of Engineers property line monument No. 1115-1, North $87^{\circ}12'17''$ East 144 feet along the Government property line to a point, said point being the intersection of the centerline of the proposed easement and the Government property line and also being the point of beginning; thence South $02^{\circ}47'43''$ East 15.00 feet to a point, said point being the intersection of the centerline of the proposed driveway and the centerline of the existing county road.

Drive No. 2 - From U. S. Corps of Engineers property line monument No. 1115-1, North $87^{\circ}12'17''$ East 20.0 feet along the Government property line to a point, said point being the intersection of the centerline of the proposed easement and the Government property line and also being the point of beginning; thence, South $02^{\circ}47'43''$ East 20.0 feet to a point, said point being the intersection of the centerline of the proposed easement and the centerline of the existing county road.
